From US-460 Westbound: Take Exit Ramp toward US-460-BUS W/VA-714. Turn Left onto N Bridge St, which becomes E Main St. Go approximately 1.2 Mi (during which time E Main St. becomes Link Rd, which in turn, becomes Falling Creek Road); PSA office is on the right.

From US-460 Eastbound: Take Exit Ramp toward US-460-BUS W/VA-714. Turn Right onto E Main St. Go approximately 1.2 Mi (during which time E Main St. becomes Link Rd, which in turn, becomes Falling Creek Road); PSA office is on the right.

From Alta Vista: Take US-43 North into Bedford. Just outside of Bedford City, Turn Right onto Skinnell Mill Road. Go 1.2 mi and Turn Left onto Falling Creek Road. Go 1.4 mi and PSA is on the Left.

From Rocky Mount: Take VA-122 N (Booker T Washington Hwy) toward Bedford to the intersection of VA-122 and US-460 E /US-221 N. Turn Right to take ramp onto US-460 E /US-221 N toward Lynchburg. Go 1.5 mi and Take Exit Ramp toward US-460-BUS W/VA-714. Turn Right onto E Main St.; go approximately 1.2 mi (during which time E Main St. becomes Link Rd, which in turn, becomes Falling Creek Road); PSA office is on the right.
